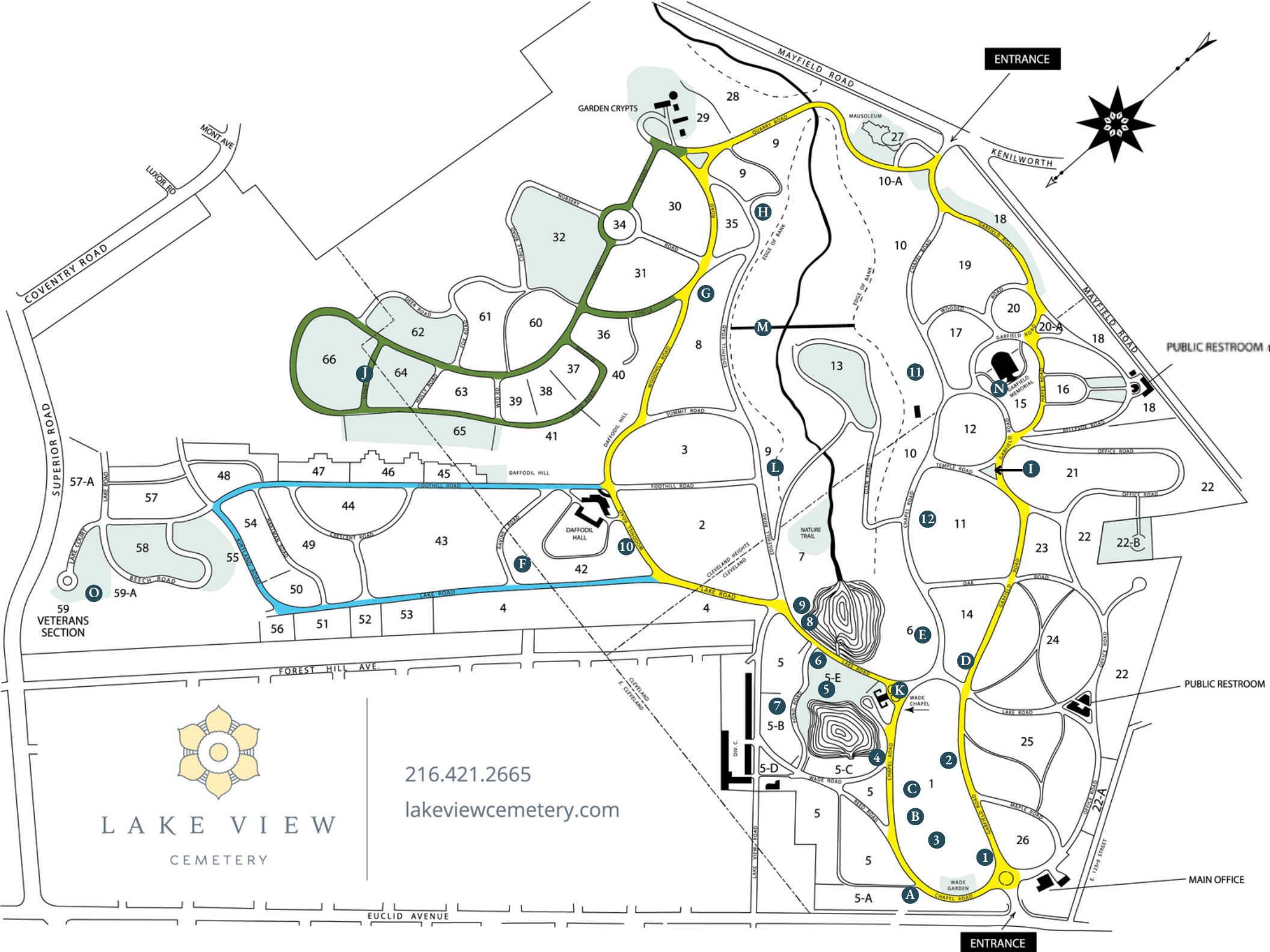

- 2 | **Captain DeForest**
First burial at Lake View Cemetery
- 3 | **Belle Sherwin**
Women's Suffragist, daughter of Henry Sherwin
- 4 | **Carl Stokes**
First African-American mayor of a major city
- 5 | **Fannie Mae Lewis**
Councilwoman and civil rights activist
- 6 | **Alan Freed**
American radio DJ, coined the term "rock 'n' roll"
- 7 | **Michael Stanley**
American singer-songwriter
- 8 | **Harvey Pekar**
Underground comic book artist
- 9 | **Eliot Ness**
American crime fighter
- 10 | **Ray Chapman**
Cleveland Indians player, only player to be killed in-game
- 11 | **Millionaires' Row**
Home to John D. Rockefeller, the Severance family, & more
- 12 | **Laura Mae Corrigan**
Socialite and early supporter of the Cleveland Zoo
